Dear Business Partner,

In the light of the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak, we would like to inform you about Lantmännen Unibake's current risk assessment and mitigation measures in relation to the virus.

The mitigation actions have been taken to reduce the risk and impact on production and deliveries.

On the employee side

We have implemented global travel restrictions until further notice. Only business critical travel is permitted, and travelling to high-risk areas is prohibited. Private travels to high-risk areas by employees are followed by a stay-home policy of two weeks to minimize the risk that colleagues are infected. If an employee should have any of the symptoms from those related to the virus, he or she is instructed to stay home from work.

Special attention to Production sites

We have taken increased safety measures to our production facilities and personnel. External visits, or visits from colleagues from another office/site, are permitted only if business-critical. No visitors are permitted who have travelled to a high-risk area within the last two weeks. Staff from transportation companies and sub-contractors such as cleaning and maintenance are required to follow the same guidelines as our employees. All employees are informed about how to minimize the risk of being infected with the virus.

Currently we assess the risk for supply of raw material from high-risk areas as low. We are in close contact with our suppliers and follow the situation carefully.

Risk assessment on Food safety

As of today, there is no indication that food is a source or route of transmission of the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, and the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) is hence not currently involved in the matter. According to the information available from public authorities, no cases have provided any evidence of humans being infected by the Corona virus by another route than animal to human or human-to-human. This, together with the relatively low environmental stability of the virus (that the virus does not survive outside of living organisms for a longer period), make it unlikely for food items to be a source of infection.

Currently we do not have operations in any of the high-risk countries. We are closely monitoring the situation especially in relation to our products and operations, and we will inform you without delay if any changes in the risk assessment should occur.

We have put in place a dedicated team responsible for monitoring and updating our risk assessment and related actions. Please do not hesitate to reach out to your primary point of contact within Lantmännen Unibake in case you have any further questions.
